Fees and sessions

	Per day	Fees include:
Morning session 8:00am – 1pm	£40	Nappies, breakfast, midmorning snack and lunch

A minimum of 2 sessions

(A short or full day is classed as two sessions)

Charged over 51 weeks (closed for 1 week at Christmas with the possibility of being closed on Christmas Eve – you will be notified about this if that is the case).

A £50 deposit is required to secure you place which will be deducted off your first invoice.

There are no further registration or administrative costs

We invoice monthly and they are due by the 1st of every month.

Price of sessions x number of sessions per week x 51 weeks ÷ 12 months = Monthly fee

We charge for bank holidays

10% Sibling discounts available

Absence due to holiday or sickness is non-refundable

Funding

We offer funding 3 types of funding for children:

1, Universal entitlement for 3 & 4 year olds

All children age 3 & 4 are entitled. Children qualify the term after their 3rd birthday.

Children are entitled to 15 hours free child care (term time) or stretched over 51 weeks giving 11.18 hours per week.

2, 2help funding for 2 year olds.

This is means tested and can be applied for by qualifying families and can start the term after their 2nd birthday. Qualifying children are entitled to 15 hours free child care (term time) or stretched over 51 weeks giving 11.18 hours per week. 3, 30 hours free childcare for working families.

Qualifying families can claim 30 hours free funding for term time only or 22.35 hours per week if stretched over 51 weeks.

Funded places can be funded only, or additional hours can be purchased.

For example, if your child does 3 days a week (10 hours a day) all year round and is entitled to 30 hours funding term time, then 7.45 hours of your child's day would be covered by funding and the additional 2.65 hours would be paid for. If you wish for your child to do 2 days a week, this could be fully covered by your funding all year round by accessing 1,020 hours of your annual funding.

Funded hours would usually be spread across the year to keep fees the same every month. If you join part way through the academic year, your funded hours will be stretched from the month you join until the end of August. For example, if you join in January you will be entitled to 24 weeks of funded hours instead of 38 weeks of funded hours and this will be stretched from January to August.

We also offer a limited number of fully funded term time only places.

If you have any other questions about how funding is offered then please ask the manager who will be happy to assist.

Voluntary Consumables

Consumables are things that we offer at Kings Meadow that aren't covered by government funding. These things may be covering basic everyday things that make life easier or enhanced resources beyond what is required in the EYFS.

Food Consumables

Breakfast – Selection of cereals, fruit and milk

Snacks – breadsticks, fruit and vegetable fingers, milk

Lunch – A variety of hot meals, nutritionally balanced with low fat no added sugar deserts.

Tea – A variety of lighter mealtime options such as soup or sandwiches, with a selection of vegetable sticks and fruit

Non- Food consumables

Gardening equipment like seeds, compost and pots	50p per session

Outsourced activities (forest school, twirling toddlers, sports lessons)	75p per session

If you are unable to cover the cost of consumables, please speak with the manager to discuss alternative options such as providing your own consumables (e.g. suncream, calpol, nappies etc) and opting out of paid activities.

At Kings Meadow we believe every child in our care should be fed our nutritious meals, with this in mind if you are unable to pay for meals, we can arrange for meals to be provided so your little one doesn't miss out.

Example 1

Child attends 3 Days a week. Receives 30 hours a week funding for 38 weeks of the year stretched over 51 weeks of the year and is able to pay the voluntary consumables charge. Hours and charges are calculated annually to give the same monthly amount.

Additional funding

Early years pupil premium (EYPP)

This funding can be claimed by providers to help support your child.

Who can apply

You can apply for early years pupil premium if your child is aged 9 months to 4 years old and you get any of the following:

- 30 hours of Free Childcare for Working Parents
- 15 hours of free childcare for 2 year olds if you get extra support
- 15 hours of free childcare for all 3 and 4 year olds

You must also get at least one of the following:

- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year after tax, not including any benefits you get

You may also get early years pupil premium if your child is currently being looked after by a local authority in England or Wales or if your child has left care in England or Wales through:

- adoption
- special guardianship order
- a child arrangements order

Disability access fund (DAF)

The disability access fund can be claimed by providers to support the education of your child.

Your early years provider can apply to get disability access funding if your child receives Disability Living Allowance for children and one of the following:

- 30 hours of Free Childcare for Working Parents
- 15 hours of free childcare for 2 year olds if you get extra support
- 15 hours of free childcare for all 3 and 4 year olds

You do not need to use all of your hours to be eligible for disability access funding.

If you believe your child is eligible for either EYPP or (DAF) please speak to the manager.
